THE RESEARCHER

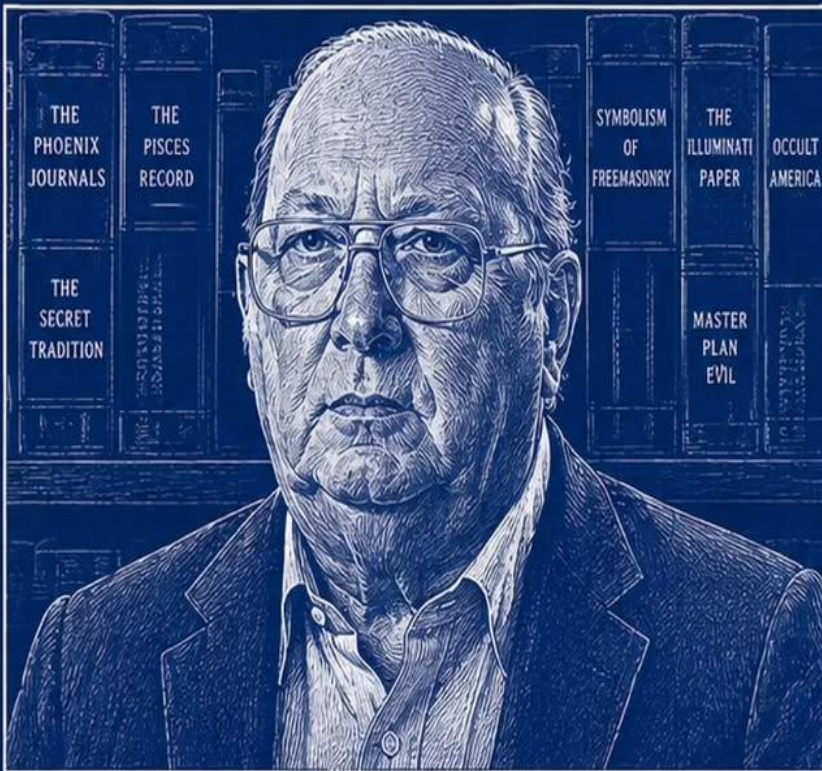
